## Retro style on display in Margaret River

INSPIRED by the characteristic design features that defined the 1960s, Summit Home's first Margaret River display home, the Retro, is a modern home with a funky twist.

It offers a big gourmet kitchen complete with scullery as well as a bar, entertainment room, open plan living/dining area that opens to a covered alfresco, plus four bedrooms (or optional study), two bathrooms and a powder room, all under the clean lines of a raked skillion roof.

As displayed, the Retro offers 260sqm of living area (including alfresco) with a total area of 306sqm and is designed to fit on lots 15.5m wide with variations available.

General manager David Hunt said homebuyers who wanted to make a strong street impression would love this home as it mixed the best of classic design principles with fresh, modern influences.

"Design is an ever-evolving process and, in listening to our customers,

we are hearing that what was popular in the 60s and 70s is now making a strong resurgence," he said.
