Home to fund research

A NEW charity home to benefit the Cancer Council WA is under construction in the South West.

Summit Realty South West has taken its commitment to supporting worthy causes one step further by building a charity home.

The home, which is slated for completion at the beginning of next year, will either be auctioned or sold by private treaty with the proceeds going toward cancer research.

“We are always looking for other

The four-bedroom, two-bathroom home is being built in a new display village in Millbridge Estate which will allow for ample public exposure.
