The Review's galley-style kitchen, which is divided from the open-plan living area by an island bench and breakfast bar, is the ultimate style for entertainers.

An open layout provides plenty of room for cooking and preparation but the kitchen's position in the centre of the home gives it the perfect vantage point for supervision and interaction.

A sleek design and neutral colour scheme ensures the look is modern but classic, with features such as a bulkhead ceiling, glazed double pantry doors and 30mm Freestyle postformed benchtops.

All appliances are stainless steel by Ariston and included are a 900mm oven and a 600mm oven, a range hood and a six-burner gas cooktop with wok burner. There are recesses for the microwave, dishwasher, fridge and freezer to keep everything streamlined.

Other features include Stylus and Dorf chrome mixers, pot drawers and soft-closing drawers and doors.

Both bathrooms feature quality fittings and fixtures, including vitreous china basins, Dorf chrome mixers, semi-frameless pivot shower doors and screens, Freestyle postformed or square-radius
