Astor puts on a star performance

Perth's Astor Theatre inspired the name and design of Summit Homes' impressive South Yunderup display, which includes a purpose-built home cinema among its best features.

The four-bedroom, two-bathroom home is well suited to families who enjoy sitting back in comfort to watch a favourite film or TV show, or host a dinner party, barbecue or other social event for friends.

It boasts a spacious and versatile open-plan living zone, with seamless links between the interior and a sheltered alfresco area, plus four big bedrooms, zoned to give adults and children ample space and privacy.

Summit Homes sales and marketing manager Tim Underwood said the Astor was designed to provide the biggest family with ample space for everyday living and special events with friends.

Mr Underwood said the home theatre was a definite highlight of the display, which was named after the Astor Theatre.

"Summit Homes are built around people and increasingly we are finding our customers want to

recreate the cinema experience in their own homes," he said.

"It's at the rear of the home and its long entry corridor was designed to allow customers to feel like they are actually walking into a cinema."

The open-plan kitchen, living, dining and alfresco area was designed to accommodate a lifestyle centred on entertaining and social activities with friends or family, he said.

The kitchen has a modified galley layout, with stone benchtops — extending to waterfall edges on a long island bench — plus stainless-steel cooking appliances and plenty of storage space, including overhead cupboards and a walk-in pantry.

It is positioned between the dining area and living zone, with the island bench commanding an outlook to the adjacent alfresco area, accessed through glazed sliding doors.

The main suite has a sleeping area brightened by three vertical windows, a deep L-shaped walk-in robe, and an elegant ensuite with overhanging basins in the double vanity unit.

The home was an entry in the 2010 HIA-NAB Perth Housing Awards.
