You no longer have to think and live small

If you're looking for a functional family home on a narrow lot, Summit Homes' newly expanded range of home designs might be just the ticket.

The builder's narrow-lot range has been expanded to include 16 homes, all of which have been designed to suit lots 14m-wide or less.

The range included varying levels of specification, meaning that clients could choose a home that would suit their lifestyle and budget, Summit's sales and marketing manager Tim Underwood said.

"Narrow-lot living no longer means clients need to think and live small," he said. "Our expanded narrow-lot range shows you can make a statement on lots as small as 10m wide and enjoy all of the benefits of a functional stylish family home."

The most compact home in the range is the Middleton Cottage, which, at 8.87m wide and with just under 200sqm of total area, has been

designed to fit perfectly on a 10m-wide block.

Of the designs in the range, about half had the builder's "select" specification and the others came with its "display" specification. The latter included 31-course ceilings and Freestyle benchtops to the kitchen, bathroom and ensuite. Three of Summit's narrow-lot designs are on

display — the Chessell Cottage and the Waterside, both in Champion Lakes, and the Aurora in Aveley.
